Easter Bonnets!



With Easter just round the corner, not far away, why not get creative with your Bingster and make a fabulous Easter bonnet, with lots of lovely Bing accessories. This activity sheet includes a pair of sticky-uppy Bing and Sula ears and Spring shapes which your Bingster can enjoy decorating and sticking on to their fabulous Bing bonnet.

You will need:

- A4 sheets of card
- Safety scissors
- Glue or Sellotape
- Pens, pencils, stickers, glitter or anything your Bingster wants to decorate with.



Instructions:

1. Cut out the two headband pieces and stick them together to create one long strip. Now place the strip around your Bingster's head like a crown and stick the two ends together to make sure you have a close fit.
2. Carefully cut out your Bingster's chosen ears (Bing's or Sula's). Then cut out any of the shapes and accessories that your Bingster would like to use as decorations.

3. Now it's time to get creative and decorate the ears and accessories however your Bingster likes... You could use crayons, paint and even glitter to give it some extra sparkle magic!
4. After your Bingster has finished decorating their ears, you could stick them onto some card to make them even more sticky-uppy (We found that a cereal box works well).
5. Now stick your Bingster's decorated ears in position on the headband and add your Easter shapes, allowing time for any glue, glitter or paint to dry.

Please use caution and your own good judgement about which steps your Bingster can safely be involved in.
